## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Round-trip coach class on American, Delta, United or other IATA member. Meals served in flight.

**LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES:** By deluxe air-conditioned motor coach with professional driver, services or an English-speaking Tour Guide, all admission & entrance fees and transfers to and from international airports. Mass scheduled daily. Daily schedule as per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify or adjust any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

**LODGING:** First-class hotel based upon double or triple occupancy with limited single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$300.

**MEALS:** Breakfast buffet and Dinner DAILY.

**ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE:** All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

**GROUP REQUIREMENT:** The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

**DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT:** A deposit/payment of \$400 towards the price of the tour, per person is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full 60 days prior to departure. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$50 late payment fee. Reservations made within 60 days of departure may be subject to a \$100 late reservation fee. Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance brochure will be mailed to you.

**INSURANCE:** Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by CSA Travel Protection's plan, as long as your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. Waivers for pre-existing medical conditions are available at no additional cost, but your policy must be purchased before your final payment for the tour.

**CANCELLATION FEES:** Passengers not taking the CSA travel insurance need to be aware of the following cancellation fees. From day of registration to 60 days prior to departure, there is a non-refundable administration fee of \$50. The remaining cancellation fee schedule is as follows: 59-46 days = \$400; 45-30 days = 50% of tour price; 29-15 days = 75% of tour price; 14 days or less = 100% of total cost.

## **A 6-DAY PILGRIMAGE TO OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE**

### **UNDER THE SPIRITUAL DIRECTION OF FATHER DWIGHT BAKER**

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#### **April 24, 2017 - Monday BOSTON / MEXICO CITY**

This morning we gather for our departing flight from Boston's Logan Airport, arriving in Mexico City in the afternoon. Upon our arrival we are met by our Pilgrimage Tours' tour director who will remain with us until the end of our tour. We celebrate Mass at the Sacred Heart Church before arriving at our hotel for dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

#### **April 25, 2017 - Tuesday OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE / TEPEYAC HILL**

After breakfast, we depart for Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Following Mass, we tour the grounds and visit the museum that houses a collection of paintings and colonial religious art by pilgrims in gratitude and thanks for miracles. We ascend Tepeyac Hill to visit the Capilla del Cerrito, the place of the apparitions of the Virgin Mary to Juan Diego in 1531. Next we see Tepeyac Garden and its statues symbolizing the union of the Aztec people and the Spanish Christian mission. A stop at the Chapel of the Indians completes the tour. Later in our day we drive to Chapultepec Park to visit the National Museum of Anthropology. We will also see a number of historical sites during the driving portion of our tour. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

#### **April 26, 2017 - Wednesday MEXICO CITY / ZOCALO PLAZA**

Following breakfast, we drive to the historical archaeological center of Mexico to celebrate Mass at Santo Domingo Church, which houses two shrines; Our Lady of the Rosary and Our Lady of Cavadonga. Following Mass, we drive past the National Palace, continuing on to Zocalo Plaza where we visit the largest cathedral in Latin America, the Metropolitan Cathedral, where Juan Diego's Bishop, Juan Zumarraga is buried. We continue our walking tour passing by the site of the Palace of the Archbishop where Juan Diego unfurled his tilma and flowers fell to the ground and the miraculous image of the Virgin Mary appeared on the cloth. Our day concludes with a visit to Garibaldi Square to enjoy the Mariachi Bands. Dinner and overnight in Mexico City.

#### **April 27, 2017 - Thursday TLAXCALA / OUR LADY OF OCOTLAN / PUEBLA**

This morning we depart for Tlaxcala, the smallest of Mexico's States, for a visit and celebration of Mass at the Shrine of San Miguel del Milagro, site of apparitions of St. Michael the Archangel and the spring of curative waters blessed by St. Michael. Next we drive to Tlaxcala City to visit the Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady of Ocotlan, "place of the burning oak", where Mary caused her image to be burned into the tree. In the afternoon we continue on to Mexico's most beautiful city Puebla, situated at an elevation of 7,000 feet near Mexico's snow-capped peaks. Puebla is well known for its beautiful churches and its hand-painted tiles, or "Talavera". While in Puebla, we visit Santo Domingo Church, where we see its beautiful Chapel of the Rosary, followed by a visit

to Puebla Cathedral, dedicated to the Immaculate Conception. The remainder of our time before dinner is free for shopping the many vendors in Puebla. Our day in Puebla concludes with dinner at a local restaurant. Following dinner, we return to Mexico City for overnight.

#### **April 28, 2017 - Friday TLATELOLCO / TULPETLAC / TEOTIHUACAN**

This morning we drive to Tlatelolco to visit the Square of the Three Cultures, where we visit and celebrate Mass at St. James Church. It is here that Juan Diego was baptized as a child. Next we drive to Tlaxpetlac for a visit to the Shrine of the Fifth Apparition, where Juan Diego's uncle experienced his own apparition of the Virgin Mother. We continue on to Teotihuacan and visit the incredible ruins of the Pyramid of the Sun and Moon. We return to Mexico City for this evening's "Fiesta Mexicana Folklorico Show" at El Lugar de Mariachi Restaurant. Overnight in Mexico City.

#### **April 29, 2017 - Saturday MEXICO CITY / BOSTON**

Following breakfast this morning we check-out of our hotel and drive to the airport for our return flight home. Though our pilgrimage draws to a close, its blessings will last a lifetime and its graces are certain to draw us closer to the Lord.
